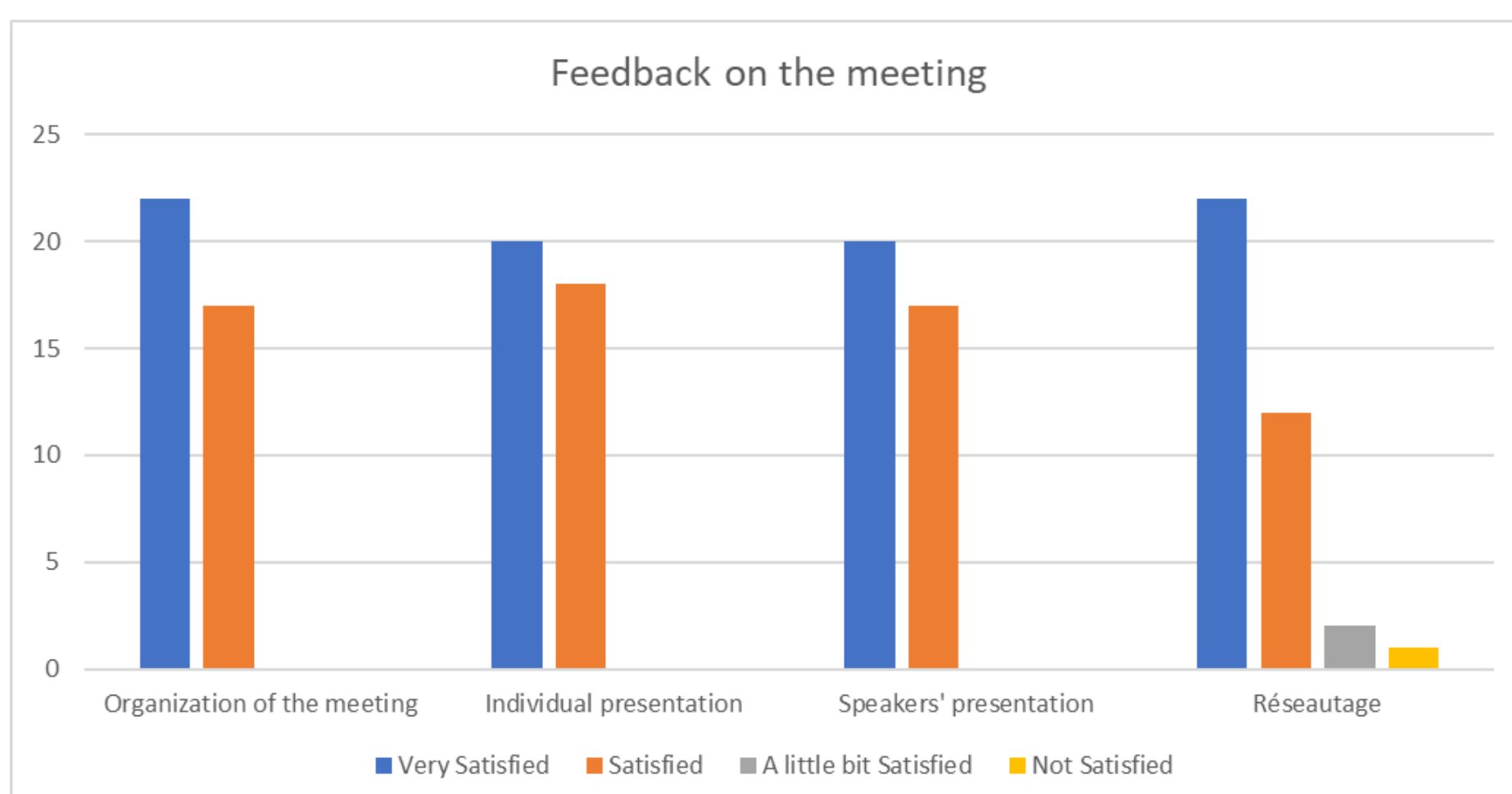
Networking at the heart of our mission

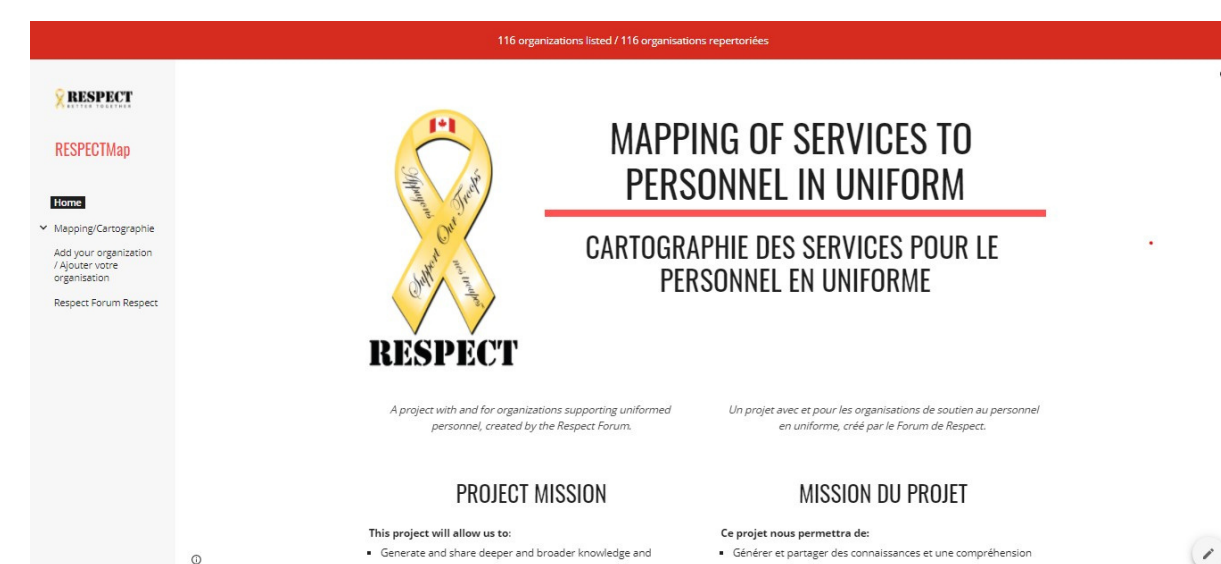


Relevant and necessary mapping!
