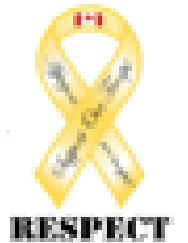
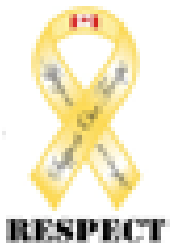

Using Framework to Develop Service Maps

	Phase 1	Phase 2	Phase 3	Phase 4
Description	Prevention, Prep, Planning & Education	Intervention	Stabilization	Reintegration & Recovery
Mandated Service Providers	Organizations publicly mandated to achieve positive outcomes in each phase. <u>Government or employer related</u> mandates (usually with specific budgets and outcomes)			
Other Service Providers (profit or non-profit)	Organizations or stakeholders whose mission entails achieving positive outcomes in each phase. Profit, non-profit, professional, advocacy, etc.			
Programs and Systems	Programs and systems oriented to achieving positive outcomes in each phase.			
Methodologies	Methodologies oriented to achieving positive outcomes in each phase.			
Metrics and Indicators	Metrics and indicators oriented to achieving positive outcomes in each phase.

- 4. Takes you to your presentation page – go to Claim listing and add listing information**
- 5. Then follow the prompts to fill in: personal information, contact information, geographical information**
- 6. Then select respect forum (many choices – drop down-pick as many as you work in**
- 7. Fill in what you offer in services, methodologies, metrics, etc**
- 8. Share with partners.**
